Selecting SCCAL Senior Athletes-of-the-Year

1. Each Spring, as the SCCAL spring sports are concluding, the SCCAL AD's will convene and select a Male and Female SCCAL Senior Athlete-of-the-Year.
2. Criteria:
 - a. The nominees must be seniors.
 - b. They must be attending an SCCAL school.
 - c. All CIF sports will be considered (eg, football is currently a PCAL sport, but football players can be nominated and selected).
3. Process:
 - a. AD's have unlimited nominations.
 - b. After nominations have concluded, the Commissioner will create a ballot.
 - i. Supporting qualifications will be included on the ballot.
 - ii. AD's can offer additional support of their nominees.
 - c. AD's have one vote in each category.
 - i. The student-athlete receiving the most votes is the winner.
 - ii. The Commissioner will not vote except in cases of ties.
4. Awards - the SCCAL will provide a plaque or another similar award to the winners.
5. Additional criteria - Do we reward excellence, or really good?
 - a. Single-sport athletes should dominate their sport.
 - b. Multiple-sport athletes should demonstrate excellence across the spectrum (but do not have to necessarily dominate their sports).
 - c. Athletic achievements from previous years are not part of the voting consideration, this is a senior-year award, but they should not be completely ignored.
